SKYWIDE ARC FOX HUNT RULES

Check in with base camp at the foot of Marie Curtais Park. Net control is available on 147.400 MHz. You will be checked-in, and may join a group. Instructions will be given. This is a friendly fun event.

Base camp W3W location:

The radio foxes can be found on:

147.4125 MHz 147.43125 MHZ 147.450 MHz



Head out with your portable radio, your attenuator and friends. Remember to not key the radio your attenuator is attached to. One of the members in your group should have their radio set to 147.400 MHz to communicate with net control. You may ask net control for clues if you struggle to find the fox.



WHEN YOU'RE NEAR THE FOX

Look for bright green tape near or under the fox. It may be on a tree branch, affixed to an object or an in ground flag. You will see three words on the tape - do not share or repeat these words outside of your group or over the air



WHAT 3 WORDS

USE THE WHAT 3 WORDS

Once you've found the three word site identifier, contact net control on 147.400 MHz and let them know you've found the fox but do not reveal any words. Net control will ask for specific letters to confirm, e.g, "the third letter of each word"



If you see the radio fox please leave it in place and do not remove anything from the location

Participants in the fox hunt will be scored based on time, difficulty and the number of clues they utilize to find the fox. A virtual trophy will be awarded.

After the hunt, return to base camp for refreshments, snacks and a good time. Foxes may be relocated in the event they are found by the majority of participants.
